State postpones ISSMA contest scheduled for Saturday at Carroll High School due to travel concerns

Carroll will instead host the regional solo and ensemble contest next weekend

Fort Wayne, Ind. (Friday, February 4, 2022) – Officials from the Indiana State School Music Association decided to postpone by a week tomorrow's regional solo and ensemble contests scheduled across the state. Carroll High School is set to host the northeastern Indiana's contest Feb. 5; however, the rescheduled event is now on Saturday, Feb. 12.

ISSMA informed organizers this morning of the delay due to hazardous road conditions from the snow effecting the entire state. Carroll's Choir Director Jill Jerran expects 48 schools from Allen, DeKalb, Elkhart, LaGrange, Noble, Steuben and St. Joseph counties to participate in the competition. The event is planned to take place from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. next Saturday.
